• Guidelines for Paper Submission

The KSECE Program Committee invites individuals to submit proposals by **July 20th**, **2012**, for Symposia, Papers, and Posters. Conference participants are invited to send proposals that correspond to the conference theme.

proposal can be submitted for:

Symposia	Sessions are designed to present a set of key-note issues related to one topic or area. Usually a group of individuals who have a common research focus or who have collaborated on a series of studies from research on the topic will be presenters. At least three presenters are required to form a symposium.
Individual Papers	Individuals will have 20 minutes to present their papers. Additional time (about 10 minutes) at the end of the session will be provided for audience questions and discussion. Presenters must agree to stay within their allotted time, in fairness to all in the session.
Research Posters (Including virtual	Presenters will share their research studies in poster format and answer attendees questions and engage in discussion of the research elements during the session.
